

Health & Safety Management Policy

- Comply with local legislation, industry codes of practice and international regulations and monitor WHS implementation to ensure compliance.
- Conduct activities in a manner designed to minimize WHS risks to a level, which is As Low As Reasonably Practicable (ALARP).
- Provide detailed position descriptions, holding all levels of management, supervisors and employees, accountable for WHS performance.
- Consult with all stakeholders with regard to WHS, including workers, supervisors, contractors, suppliers, clients, as well as with independent safety professionals.
- Monitor, measure, appraise and report on WHS performance and set targets for continuous improvement.
- Provide and maintain safe and healthy work places, plant and equipment, safe operating systems and work procedures to achieve required standards.
- Mitigate all WHS deficiencies and non-conformances identified through audits, inspections and incident investigations as well as other sources, in a timely manner.

The Directors shall take all necessary steps to ensure that this policy is implemented. All AMAP personnel shall understand and enact their health and safety related responsibilities in order to successfully implement this policy.
